5 Blooming Indoor Plant Ideas

01

Hoya Carnosa

Wax plants, honey plants, or porcelain flowers.

- can grow well in any climate
- endure low-light environments

02

Hydrangeas

Hydrangea flowers or Hortensia flowers.

- tolerate nearly any soil, as long as it is moist
- direct sunlight placement

03

Gloxinia

Sinningia speciosa, native to Brazil tropical region, relative to African violets.

- prefers bright, filtered sunlight
- likes moderately moist soil
- dislikes getting their leaves wet

Anthurium

Tailflower, flamingo flower, or a laceleaf

- red, white, pink, or purple heart-shaped flowers
- endure well with indirect light, year-round humid weather, and moist soil
- keep away from children and pets (poisonous if ingested by mistake)

05

Kalanchoe

Kalanchöe, Kalanchoë, or Widow's-thrill, a tropical perennial succulent

- silky green leaves with lively red, yellow, pink, and orange blooms
 - grows well in bright, indirect light
 - likes to dry out between waterings
